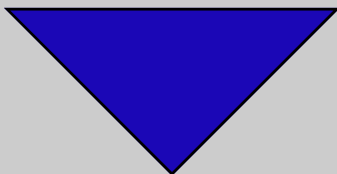

## **RecycleNet Launches Scrap China Corporation**

Salt Lake City, August 2, 2005: Paul Roszel, Chairman & CEO of RecycleNet Corporation (OTC: GARM) is pleased to announce the incorporation of Scrap China Corporation. Scrap China will add value to RecycleNet by facilitating trade of secondary commodities between North America and China.

In the year 2000, RecycleNet Corporation recognized the need for specific geographic web portals within its business and it established an online presence to correspond with each continent. The management of RecycleNet Corporation believed that the growing potential for business in Asia demanded separate attention, therefore implemented a strategy to establish a secondary commodity clearing house service in China. As a result, on June 15, 2005 a new business segment was formed, a Utah corporation, Scrap China Corporation.

Scrap China Corporation is a development stage company. The Company's plan is to set up a base of operations in China to facilitate the international trade of secondary commodities.

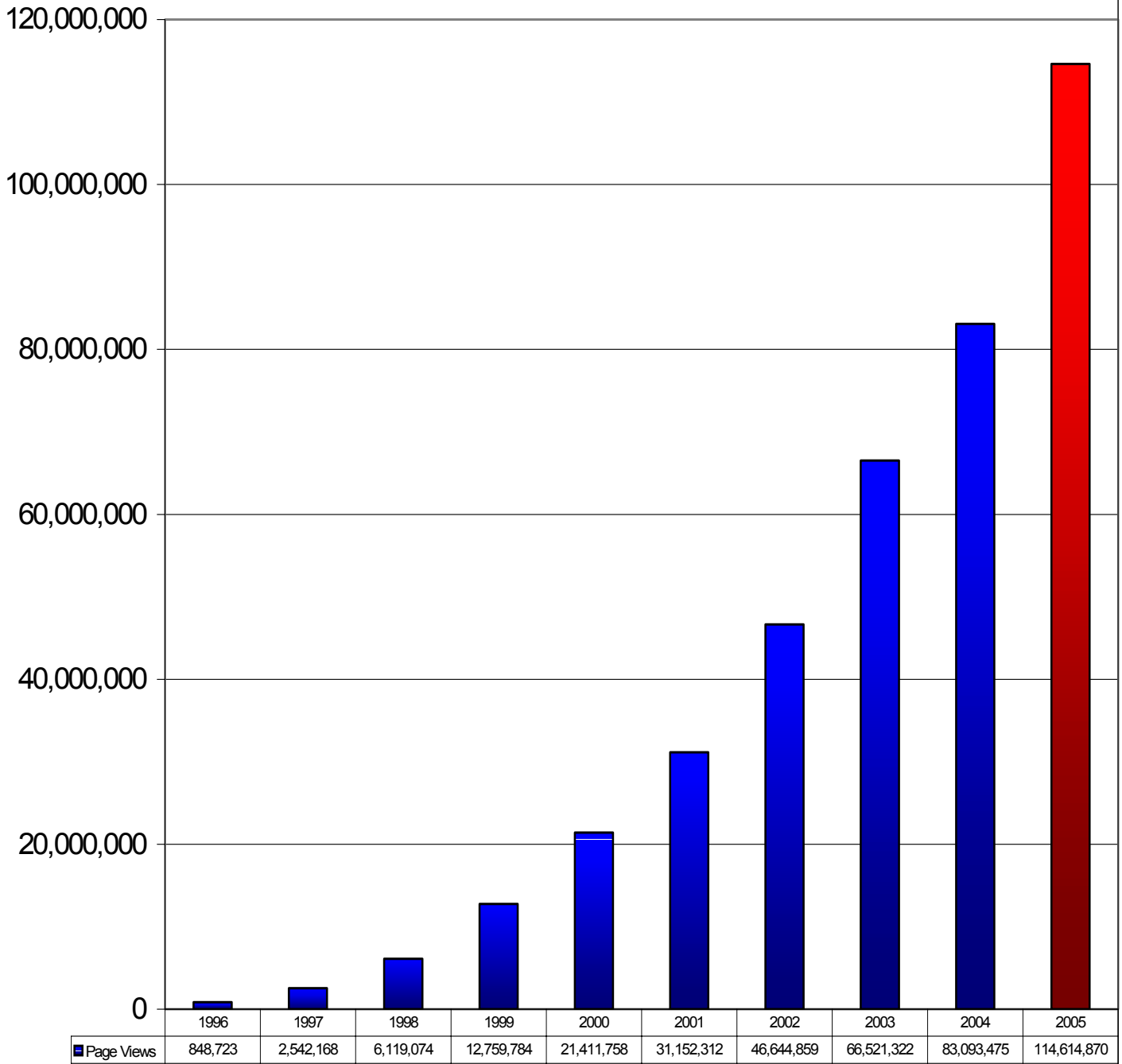

RecycleNet Corporation's regional waste exchange program is a FREE waste exchange service for generators of scrap, waste or by-product. Users can list their materials in an effort to facilitate waste diversion and minimize waste going into landfill.

Over the past several months RecycleNet Corporation has launched regional exchanges in Asia, Europe, South America, Mexico, Canada, and in 23 states across America.

## RecycleNet Introduces Grades & Specifications for WEEE Scrap

SALT LAKE CITY, UTAH, June 15, 2005 - Electronics recycling has been one of the fastest growing areas of the recycling industry. Traditional computer recycling has evolved to encompass waste electronics and electrical equipment (WEEE); this includes anything with a battery or an electrical cord.

In response to the changing needs in the industry, RecycleNet (OTC-BB: GARM) has established a series of grades and specifications to aid in the collection, sorting and trading of WEEE scrap.

WEEE scrap has been segmented into 4 groups designated by the letters M, F, B and C. The M group includes all items with a cathode ray tube (CRT). The F group includes all items with a flat screen display (LCD - liquid crystal display or plasma technology). The B group includes all items that contain a battery (excluding those items with monitors or flat screens). Lastly, group C includes those items with an electrical cord with no monitor, flat-screen or battery.

Each of the 4 groups is then subdivided into classifications by weight. These classifications are separated by items that weigh less than 10 lbs., items that weigh 10 to 50 lbs., and those items over 50 lbs.

In addition, grades and specifications have been established for Poly E-Scrap to facilitate the recycling of mixed plastics from electronics.

**Business Description**

RecycleNet Corporation operates a trading exchange for recyclable commodities. The Recycler's Exchange lists materials that include metals, paper, plastics and covers the entire spectrum of waste and scrap materials, as well as used items.

We are not dealers, brokers or processors of scrap materials, we are the exchange system for traders or anyone who wishes to buy/sell/trade waste materials.

**Market**

RecycleNet believes the marketplace for scrap materials and used items exceeds \$ 300 billion USD/year in North America. Any purchasing agent at any factory that produces scrap, waste or by-product is a potential user of our services.

RecycleNet is focused on developing a formal marketplace, concentrating on a portion of the scrap market that it can charge transaction fees of up to 10 % of the value of the goods traded on the exchange. Currently, there is not a formal exchange for scrap materials.

**Current Situation**

To date, RecycleNet has focused its efforts on building its core user base, and as a result has developed over 2.5 million unique users a month from approximately 150 countries worldwide.

The Company has been self financed, has cash in the bank and has no debt . The immediate challenge facing the company is to ramp up our business rapidly enough to secure our dominant position.

**Goals / Major Milestones**

- Ramp up the top line revenues to \$ +40 million USD/year and achieve earnings of \$ +10 million USD within 36 months of the private placement of \$ 12.3 million USD.
- Position the company for a NASDAQ listing & public offering in the \$ 100 million range.
- Ramp revenues to \$ +2 billion & earnings in the \$ 200 million range in 36-48 months of the public offering.
